

Beach Ready Spa is an unexpected oasis retreat found in Seaside

Tucked away into the secondary business street into Seaside's downtown, visitors will find a pleasant surprise.

Beach Ready Spa, located at 29 Quincy Circle, is a quiet retreat that holds pleasant surprises for those who enter.

At first glance, the storefront resembles the others in the seaside town, but a closer look reveals much more than a storefront — it is also a relaxing oasis away from the hustle and bustle that offers its guests rejuvenation.



Behind drapes, soft, soothing musical sounds set the tone, as does the dim lighting in the hallway with walls that curve like the waves outside.

Inside the five treatment rooms massages and facials are given, as well as manicures and pedicures in a separate room. There is also a two-person sauna that is complementary with all services.

The spa offers four different massages, as well as a hot-stone massage, body scrubs, wraps, body treatments, and couples massages.

Choose from seven different facials, including the cooling shells, or instant lift microcurrent, which is excellent to prepare for an upcoming special occasion such as a party or wedding.

Waxing is also available, as are shell pedicures, and Indian head massages.

Some of the treatments are 50 minutes and some are 80, depending on price.

The spa is designed to be cozy and relaxing with a beachy feel, said the spa's marketing person, Priscilla Edwards.

Looking for a place for a bridal party or girl's day out or getaway? The day spa can and does accommodate those, and makes them special with an array of services, lunch snacks or breakfast bar, champagne, and pictures.

In the spa's store, gifts and accessories are for sale, such as hats, locally made jewelry, candles, and the spa's new line of skin-care products, Pacifica. Beach balm is made in house by therapists.

"It's also a nice place homeowners can send their guests for a treat," said Edwards.

Beach Ready Spa is hosting an open house May 8 from 5-8 p.m. There will be demonstrations, free product samples, appetizers, and live music.
